Army Ranger Lead The Way Fund was named in honor of Sgt. James J. Regan, a member of the elite 75th Ranger Regiment, who gave his life in Iraq in 2007. The Fund was created to provide support to U.S. Army Rangers and their families whose needs were not being met by the Departments of Defense and Veterans Affairs. Since its inception, LTFW has distributed over \$1 million in financial assistance. LTFW programs have grown to include Wounded Ranger Recovery and Transition, Family Health and Wellness and Ranger Chaplain Programs. LTFW has provided hospital beds, home repair adjustments, travel and lodging expenses, retrofitted cars and is now building adaptable green homes for some of the most severely wounded Rangers. The future financial needs of our wounded Rangers are ongoing and we anticipate needing over \$2 million to support them.
